## 3 Player Pickleball

What do you do if you only have 3 Pickleball players. Rather than somebody sitting out, 3 Player Pickleball is a good option.

Players: Player 1 at one end \& Players $2 \& 3$ at other end.
The court: Player 1 defends only the side of the court he/she serves from (includes to doubles line). Players $2 \& 3$ defend their whole double court end.

Serving The serve rotates every 5 points. Player 1 serves 5 balls. Player 2 becomes next to serve 5 balls. Player 3 rotates \& serves next 5 balls. After serving, the singles player moves to the doubles end. Each player serves 5 balls twice.

Returns Players $2 \& 3$ stay at the baseline until the server returns the ball and it bounces. Then they return the ball and can move towards the net.

Scoring The score remains with each end and does not rotate with players. The winner therefore is not a person but an end (ie single end winner or double end winner).

Points As per normal game. There is a maximum of 30 points in total.
Note: 1. By rotating the server, single players do not get too exhausted.
2. You can modify the suggested rules to suit yourselves.
